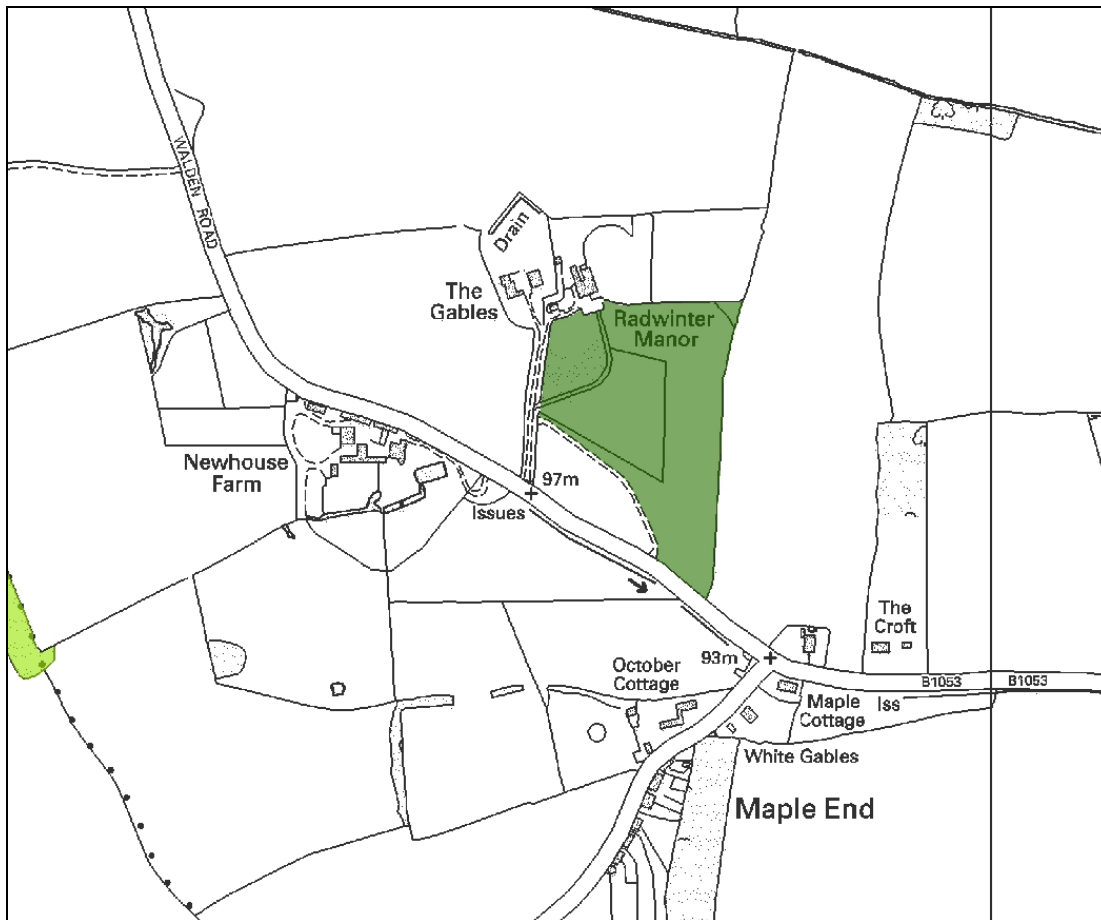

Ufd200. Radwinter Manor Place (3.0 ha) TL 596376

This site retains a species-rich sward and is one of the larger grasslands of this type in the north-east of the district. The turf is composed of Bent-grasses (*Agrostis* spp.), Meadow Foxtail (*Alopecurus pratensis*), Cock's-foot (*Dactylis glomerata*), Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*), Fescues (*Festuca* spp.) and Meadow-grasses (*Poa* spp.). The varied herb flora includes Wild Carrot (*Daucus carota*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), Ox-eye Daisy (*Leucanthemum vulgare*), Cowslip (*Primula veris*), Creeping Jenny (*Lysimachia nummularia*), Burnet Saxifrage (*Pimpinella saxifraga*) and Pepper Saxifrage (*Silaum silaus*).
