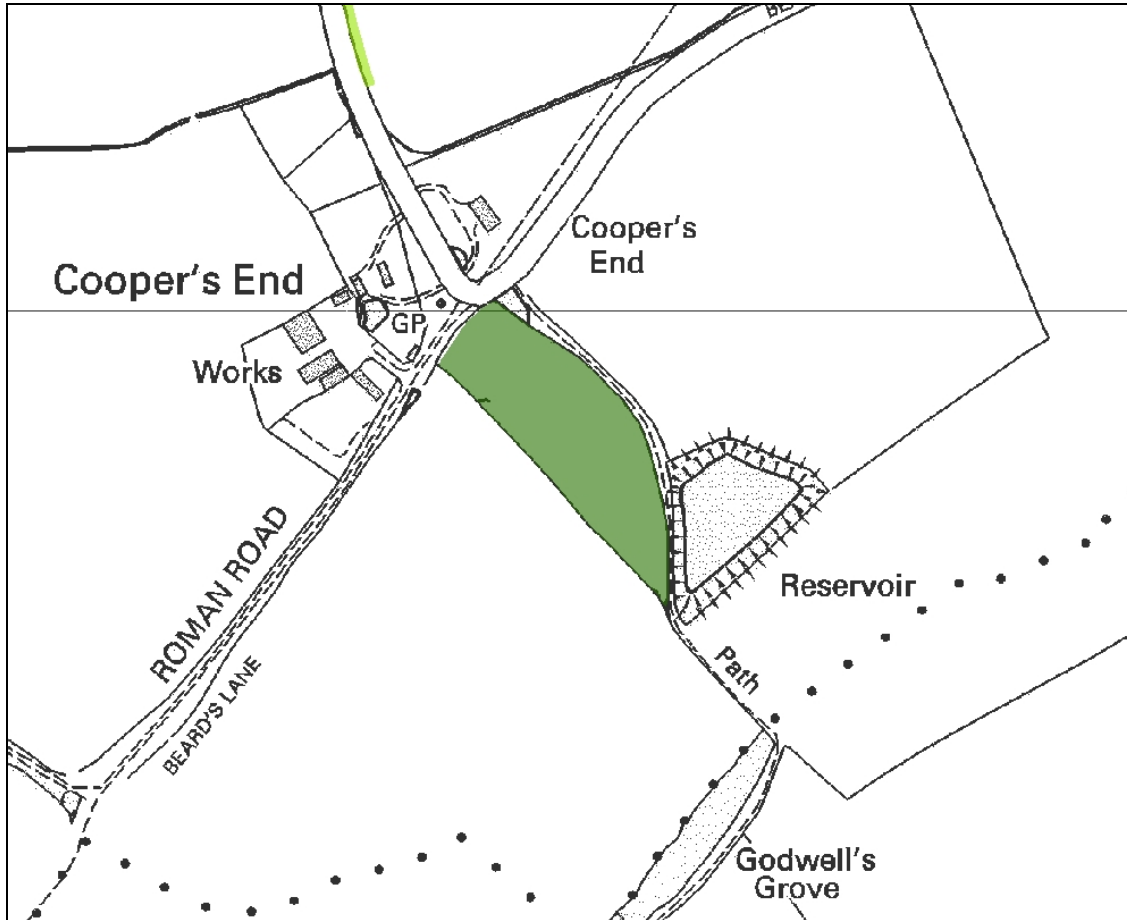

Ufd21. Cooper's End Meadow (1.4 ha) TL 466359

This site supports a notable population of Cowslip (*Primula veris*) amongst a varied grass and herb flora. Other characteristic species include Common Bent-grass (*Agrostis capillaris*), Black Knapweed (*Centaurea nigra*), Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Meadow Fescue (*Festuca pratensis*), Cat's-tail (*Phleum* spp.) and Agrimony (*Agrimonia eupatoria*). The current invasion of scrub should be controlled, although the thick hedge margin along the north and east boundary provides a useful additional habitat.
