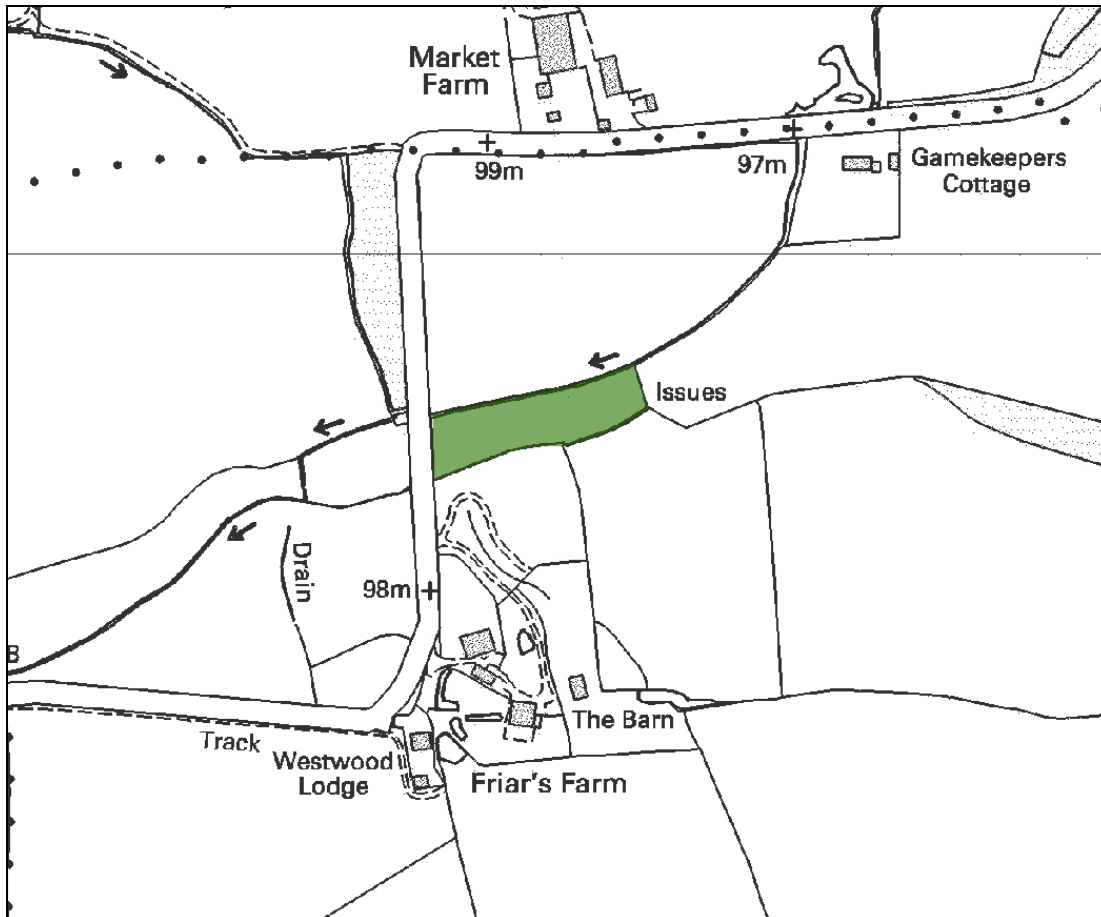

**Ufd228. Friars Farm Meadow (0.6 ha) TL 614337**

This grassland, the best of a series to the north of Friars Farm, has a varied flora which includes Lady's Smock (*Cardamine pratensis*), Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*) and Cowslip (*Primula veris*) amongst a sward of Creeping Bent-grass (*Agrostis stolonifera*), Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), False Oat-grass (*Arrhenatherum elatius*), Cock's-foot (*Dactylis glomerata*), Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*) and Yorkshire Fog (*Holcus lanatus*).
